- Profile the contributions of the RCMP to the development of Canada
- Highlight the history of the RCMP from its inception in 1873
- Recognize all those who have served throughout the years

The concept for the RCMP Veterans Legacy Pathway was inspired by many of the international and national police memorials who seek to share history and symbolism in commemorating local forces and their fallen.

Particular attention was paid to those that adopted more contemporary aspects allowing visitors to reflect on the unique experiences of their visits. Following the example of others, care has been taken to plan for the inclusion of an informative walking tour with placid stops along the way featuring benches and plaques; all to create a "history timeline" marking important dates.

The RCMP Veterans' Legacy Pathway will expand on those concepts and share particularly the history of the RCMP and its role in Canadian identity and culture.



The RCMP Commemorative Pathway Plaque Program

The RCMP Commemorative Pathway Plaque Program celebrates the legacy of the RCMP by recording and sharing the significant people, events, and accomplishments that have shaped the force over the years.

Informative plaques, equipped with bilingual inscriptions and images, are strategically placed along the serene pathways of Beechwood Cemetery.

The program has already unveiled plaques commemorating members of the RCMP who have demonstrated extraordinary bravery and service.

These plaques serve as a lasting tribute to their contributions and ensure that their legacy is remembered by future generations.













A Place for Generations to Commemorate

To commemorate the founding of the RCMP (NWMP) on May 23, 1873, the RCMP Veterans Association – Ottawa Division holds an annual sunrise vigil.

On May 23, a bugler and a piper from the RCMP Pipes and Drums start the vigil, calling serving members and veterans to participate in a sunrise Flag raising ceremony at the Main Monument recalling their basic training at Depot and to stand in repose at the Fallen Member Cenotaph from 06:00 hrs until the memorial services at 11:00 hrs.

Wreaths are placed to remember those who have served Canada diligently and their families who supported them.

Tours are provided to show respect to the over 250 North West Mounted Police, Royal North West Mounted Police, and Royal Canadian Mounted Police members buried across the National Cemetery of Canada. These were some of the members who each shaped the Force in their own way.

A Remembrance Ceremony is help prior to Remembrance Day (November 11) to honour the service of the military and para-military of the RCMP, RCMP Veterans and their families.
