Interest from the fund will be used to cover expenses for the care and maintenance of markers and monuments in perpetuity.

PAYMENT, FINANCING & FUNDING

For services at time of death:

Full payment is required before any interment or scattering service and prior to the delivery of any other services and supplies.

If the total contract amount is not paid in full at the time the contract is signed, payment is due within 30 days, beyond which interest will be charged at a monthly rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR). Payment may be made by cash, cheque, bank draft, e-transfer, Visa or Mastercard.

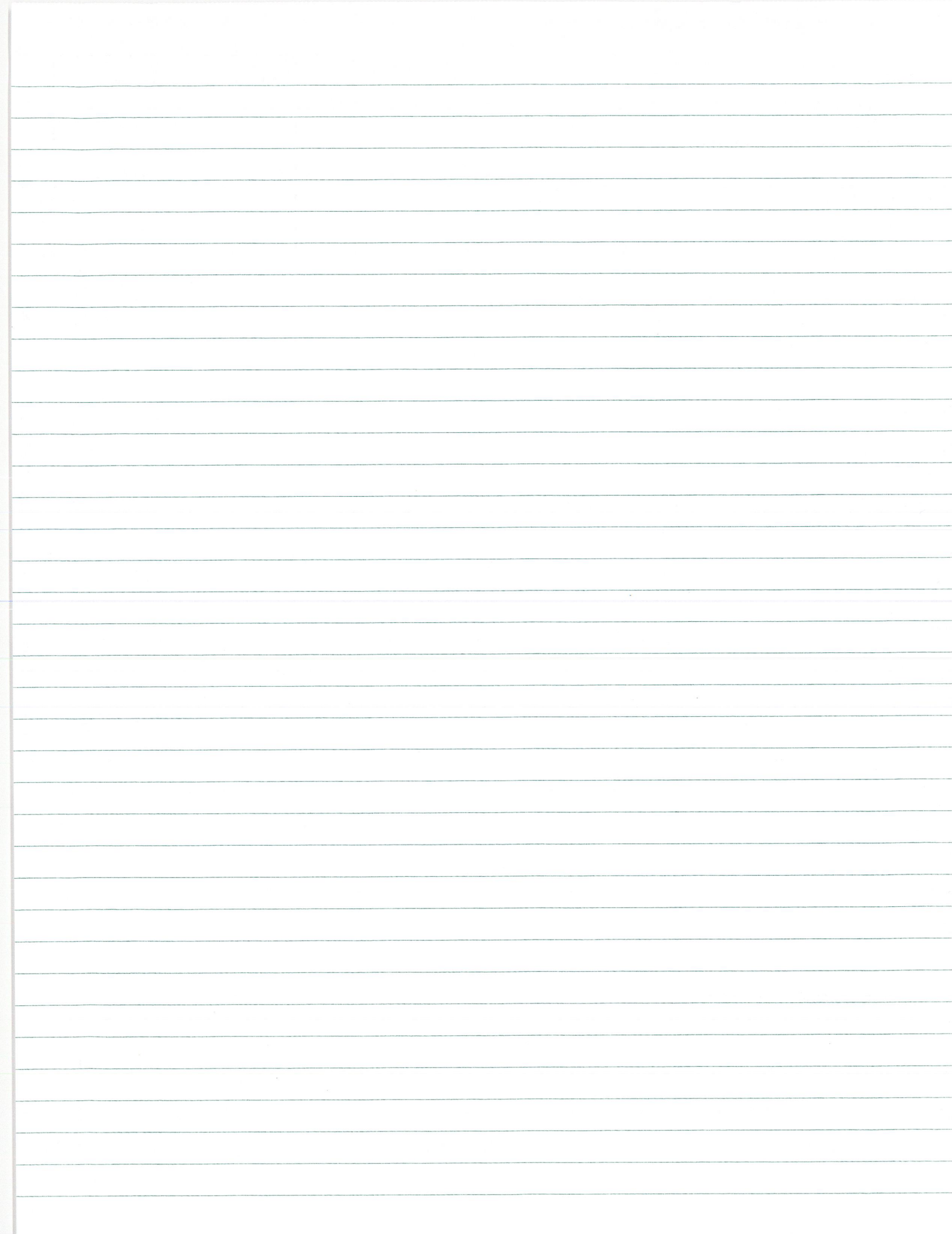
Financial assistance for burial and cremation services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services and supplies that are being arranged pre-need, you may pay for the services and supplies at today's price and we will place your money in a trust account. where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment can be made by cash, cheque, bank draft, e-transfer, Visa or Mastercard.

Guarantee: When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.

We're all about consumer protection

The Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) is a government delegated authority and not-for-profit corporation administering provisions of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 (FBCSA) on behalf of the Ministry of Public and Business Service Delivery and Procurement. Responsible for protection of the public interest, the BAO regulates, ensures compliance with the law, provides resources and services to licensed:

- Funeral establishment operators, directors and preplanners;
- Cemetery, crematorium and alternative disposition operators;
- Transfer service operators; and
- Bereavement sector sales representatives across Ontario.

The BAO is wholly funded by licensee fees (not tax dollars).

Examples of information in our free guide

Legal authority

Who has the legal authority to make decisions? Generally, the person(s) appointed as the Estate Trustee(s) has the legal authority to make such decisions. Here is a partial list of who may act as the legal representative: Estate trustee, also called an executor or executrix, who is named in the will (or an administrator appointed by the court); spouse; and, adult children, 18 or older.

Your options

What are some funeral or memorial service options? A celebration of someone's life helps surviving family and friends grieve the loss of a loved one. You can choose a funeral, memorial or graveside service. A service may be private by invitation, or public. Other options are to have a public or private visitation/viewing, a funeral procession, a home funeral and/or home vigil, or any other respectful social, traditional, or cultural ritual.

What options do I have in the final disposition of my body? Your options are burial, cremation, and alkaline hydrolysis (a chemical process reducing a body to liquid and bone components) funeral services, including transport, documentation including death registration, and body care. Services (except arterial embalming) can also be provided by family and friends for no charge or compensation.

Seeing the price is your right!

What should I know before signing a contract? Make sure you are dealing with a licensed business or individual. You may search our Public Register, found on our website. Ensure the service provider has given you a copy of its price list and cemetery or crematorium bylaws, as required by law, before signing a contract. The service provider is also required to post its price list on its public website along with a copy of the BAO Consumer Information Guide. People seeking financial assistance should not sign a contract because it could render them ineligible for assistance and responsible for paying for the contract.

A funeral director or preplanner must explain all payment options, cancellation rights and refund entitlements.

By-laws Governing the Operations of Beechwood Cemetery Company

Understanding the By-Laws

The By-laws governing the operations of The Beechwood Cemetery Company as stated herein are based on experience acquired in cemetery management since 1873. Our objective is to protect, beautify and ensure respectful care of all graves, mausolea, columbaria, crematoria and other cemetery facilities.

These by-laws are the rules and regulations that govern Beechwood Cemetery and have been approved by the Registrar of Cemeteries, FBCSA, Cemeteries Regulations Unit, Ministry of Consumer Services.

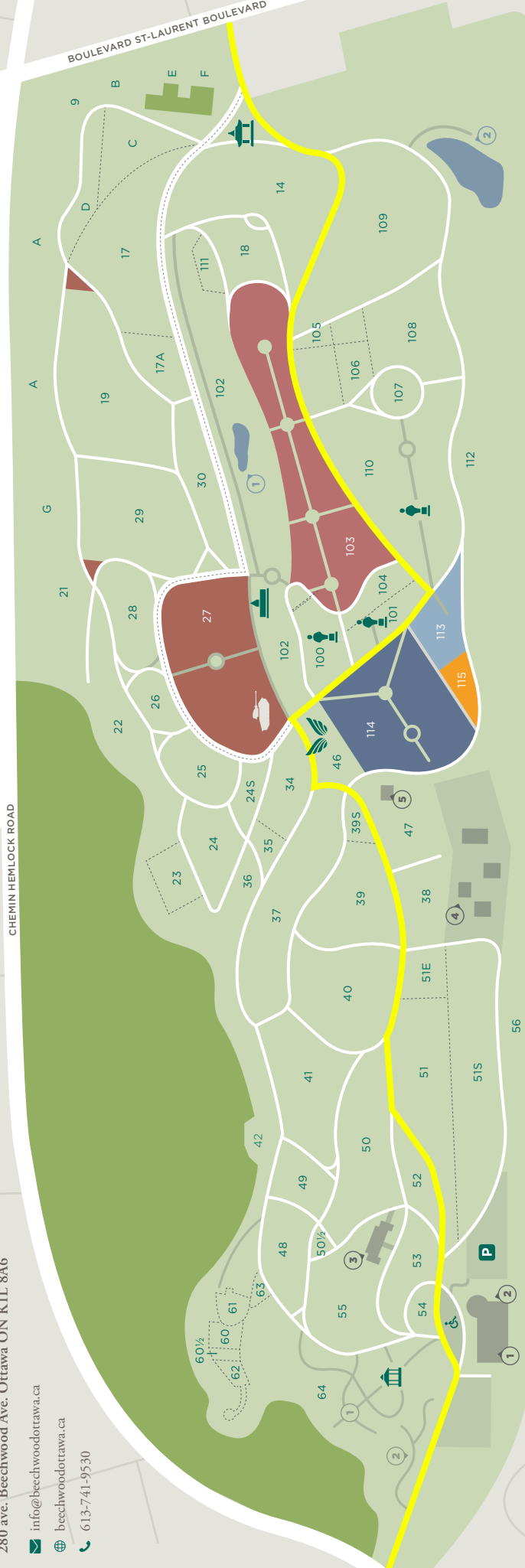
