BEECHWOOD'S FACILITIES

Whatever your wishes, Beechwood has comfortable and beautiful facilities to accommodate them. Our facilities are open to the public daily, except December 25th, January 1st, and provincial statutory holidays and you are welcome to visit, subject to availability.

Beechwood National Memorial Centre

Attached to its 19th-century stone office building is Beechwood's 7,000-square-foot state-of-the-art reception centre that provides families with classic comfort. With its sunlit wall-to-wall windows, the inviting warmth of fireplaces, and bright and gleaming hardwood floors, the centre provides reception rooms, family meeting rooms and catering facilities.



Sacred Space

One of the most impressive rooms in the Centre was conceived from extensive consultations with local faith leaders and the Ontario Multi-Faith Council. With its spectacularly sky-lit dome poised at the centre of the soaring rooftop canopy, Beechwood's nine-sided multi-functional facility, called the Sacred Space, serves the commemorative needs of Canadians of diverse backgrounds.

At the heart of the Centre lies a centuries-weathered and storied boulder unearthed from Beechwood's 160-acre property. "The rock," as it is known, has a special significance best described by the poignant words of the former Chaplain General of the Canadian Forces, B Gen (ret'd) Gerald E. Peddle:

"The rock will remind people that in the midst of transient life, there is a permanence in the grander order of things. This rock will be our silent witness of the entire passage of human life. It will remind us that in the midst of our mourning, there is another reality that is firm, steadfast, enduring and will last forever."

The acoustics in the Sacred Space are ideally suited to showcase the baby grand piano that is available for use and kept perfectly tuned.

Seating can accommodate either small groups or larger gatherings of up to 250 people. For even larger groups, additional seating can be set up in adjacent suites with full audio/video live feed.

Visitation, Reception and Family Meeting Rooms

The Centre also houses attractive visitation rooms. These modern and spacious naturally lit rooms provide families with a warm, comfortable venue for their commemorative gatherings and special events.

Should families wish to include video memorial tributes, Beechwood's visitation rooms feature large LCD flat-screen television monitors. Further, Beechwood encourages families to bring in items, such as individual photos and photo albums, to personalize and help celebrate the life of a loved one.

What are Professional Services?

Professional consultation with licensed Funeral Director, including, expert advice on options to meet your needs. Coordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by a third party. This includes the general use of the facilities for funeral arrangements, as well as the use of an administrative vehicle and staff to assist with the registration of the death at City Hall.

What types of documentation can be expected?

Completion and filing of all documents necessary for the disposition of a deceased person, including death registration, burial permit and coroner's certificate for cremation. Provision of Proof of Death Certificates issued by Beechwood, Funeral, Cemetery and Cremation Services. Administration and clerical assistance, preparing all disbursement cheques, attending to the necessary details in connection with arrangements for cremation and/or burial.

Preparation of Deceased (Requires the facility for sheltering remains) (cont.)

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives for sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. This service also includes dressing, hairdressing, cosmetics, and casketing. While embalming is not legally required, it may be necessary for transfers out of province or country. This requires the service of basic preparation and handling of the deceased.
- \$250.00** Protective Shroud and Disinfection
A disinfection method as an alternative to embalming, including the use of a Bio Seal pouch when needed.
- \$ 275.00** Washing Ceremony (1 hour - Max. 5 people)
Ask your Funeral Director for more information.
- \$ 65.00** Pacemaker or Radioactive Implant Removal
The removal of a pacemaker or Radioactive Implant must be performed by a licensed funeral director. This procedure is mandatory before the cremation of a deceased person and includes the proper disposal of the removed device.
A deceased person cannot be cremated if their remains contain a radioactive implant. An exception applies if at least two years have passed since the implant was inserted, or if a shorter period has elapsed and it has been determined that it is safe to proceed with the cremation.

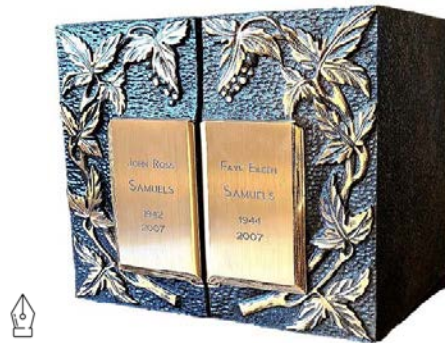

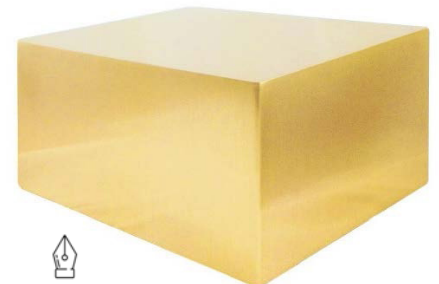

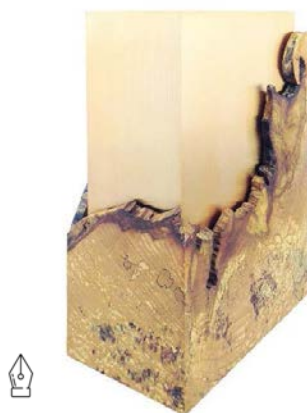

DISBURSEMENTS are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by Beechwood. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Municipal Death Registration Fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Coroner's Fee – Charged by the coroner's office for issuing a certificate which allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Cremation Fee – This is the fee charged by the crematorium to receive the remains, provide a temporary and secure holding area, ensure the cremation takes place in a timely manner, and to prepare the proper documents and return the urn to the Funeral Home.

Clergy honorarium – An amount paid to the clergy for their services. The amount is traditionally set by the clergy.

Musician – This fee is set by the individual and is paid directly to the individual.

Newspaper Notices – The Funeral Director will be happy to help compose the obituary with you and submit it to the newspaper of your choice. The amount charged varies by media type.

Grave Opening and Preparations – this is a fee charged by the cemetery to open and close the grave for either a casket or urn interment, and might also include the preparation of the graveside setting with chairs, canopy, matting, etc...

Floral Arrangements – This is generally a service that is handled between the family and the florist.

PAYMENT OPTIONS: Payment may be made by Visa, MasterCard, debit, cheque, or cash.

PAYMENT AT TIME OF DEATH: Contracts totaling \$5,500.00 or less, must be paid in full on signing of a Contract. Contracts greater than \$5,500.00 require a minimum deposit of 50%, with payment of the Total Amount Owed due within thirty (30) days of the date of the Contract. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a monthly rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18% per annum. Currently, Beechwood does not offer any in-house payment plan.

NSF CHARGES: NSF fees might be charged if a payment is dishonored, which will be added to the account balance.

FUNDING AHEAD OF TIME: We offer prepayment of services and supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

A)Funding Option in Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled. The interest that accrues is used to offset any inflationary costs of the services and supplies that are prepaid. If there are excess funds in the account at the time the services are rendered, those funds will be returned to the estate.

B)Funding Option Insurance/Annuity: You may purchase an insurance/annuity policy where the proceeds of the policy will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled. Different payment options are available to suit your needs.

If you are pre-paying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

The Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) is a government delegated authority and not-for-profit corporation administering provisions of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 (FBCSA) on behalf of the Ministry of Public and Business Service Delivery and Procurement. Responsible for protection of the public interest, the BAO regulates, ensures compliance with the law, provides resources and services to licensed:

- Funeral establishment operators, directors and preplanners;
- Cemetery, crematorium and alternative disposition operators;
- Transfer service operators; and
- Bereavement sector sales representatives across Ontario.

The BAO is wholly funded by licensee fees (not tax dollars).

Examples of information in our free guide

Legal authority

Who has the legal authority to make decisions? Generally, the person(s) appointed as the Estate Trustee(s) has the legal authority to make such decisions. Here is a partial list of who may act as the legal representative: Estate trustee, also called an executor or executrix, who is named in the will (or an administrator appointed by the court); spouse; and, adult children, 18 or older.

Your options

What are some funeral or memorial service options? A celebration of someone's life helps surviving family and friends grieve the loss of a loved one. You can choose a funeral, memorial or graveside service. A service may be private by invitation, or public. Other options are to have a public or private visitation/viewing, a funeral procession, a home funeral and/or home vigil, or any other respectful social, traditional, or cultural ritual.

What options do I have in the final disposition of my body? Your options are burial, cremation, and alkaline hydrolysis (a chemical process reducing a body to liquid and bone components) funeral services, including transport, documentation including death registration, and body care. Services (except arterial embalming) can also be provided by family and friends for no charge or compensation.

Seeing the price is your right!

What should I know before signing a contract? Make sure you are dealing with a licensed business or individual. You may search our Public Register, found on our website. Ensure the service provider has given you a copy of its price list and cemetery or crematorium bylaws, as required by law, before signing a contract. The service provider is also required to post its price list on its public website along with a copy of the BAO Consumer Information Guide. People seeking financial assistance should not sign a contract because it could render them ineligible for assistance and responsible for paying for the contract.

A funeral director or preplanner must explain all payment options, cancellation rights and refund entitlements.

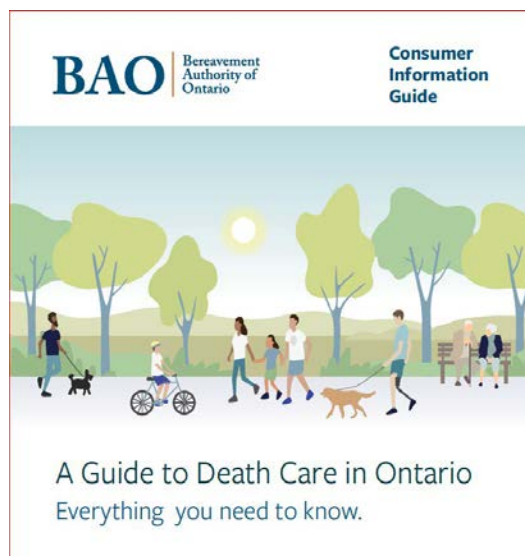
